PRACTICALITIES

- Participants arrange and pay their own travel costs.
- The host Centre or Organisation provides on-site accommodation.
- The cost for events covers all meals which are vegetarian and cooked communally by the group.
- Work tasks vary and will be matched to participants' skills and capabilities.
- Each project is led by an experienced facilitator.
- Groups are usually 8-12 people aged 18 to 80+ and all abilities.
- Projects are open to Quakers, those in sympathy with or enquiring about Friends, and all nationalities.
- Bursary help is available – please enquire.
- QVA covers personal accident insurance only.

QVA offers adventurous opportunities for volunteering that combine meaningful practical work with time for spiritual engagement, encounter and reflection.

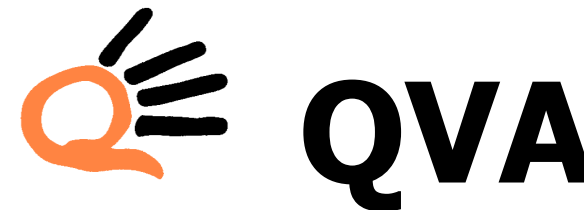

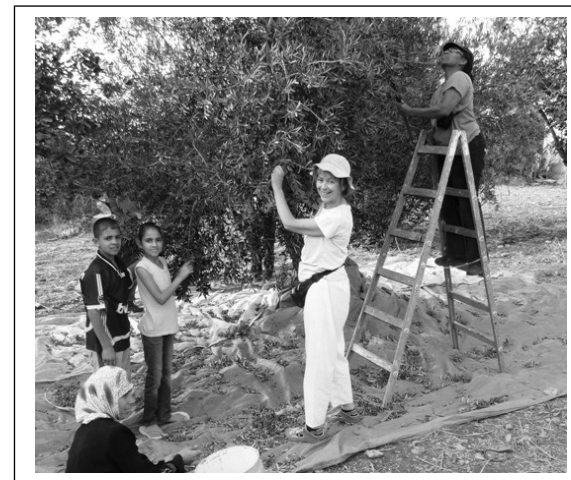

CONGENIES: FRANCE

MARCH 26-APRIL 1 (Mon-Sun) £180

The QVA season begins with a project at the 19th Century Quaker Centre in the South of France. We will help with the development of the garden & burial ground.

RAMALLAH: PALESTINE & ISRAEL

APRIL 21-MAY 2 (Sat-Wed) £390

Our Spring project in the region supports local agricultural and community initiatives in collaboration with the Friends International Centre in Ramallah. There is a strong study element and encounters with Palestinian & Israeli viewpoints.

SWARTHMOOR: CUMBRIA

MAY 7-11 (Mon-Fri) £120

Enjoy Spring in the stunning Lake District. The work in Swarthmoor's varied grounds can include anything from gentle weeding to creating a rockery or managing the meadow and orchard.

QUAKER VOLUNTARY ACTION WORKING RETREATS 2012

BAMFORD: PEAK DISTRICT

JUNE 9-16 (Sat-Sat) £160

This project is for Young Friends aged 18-30+. We will be supporting the ongoing work of the Quaker Community at Bamford in their extensive eco-managed grounds.

STONE: STAFFORDSHIRE

JULY 6-8 (Fri-Sun) £50

This collaboration with Transition Town Stone will have a surprise practical element! Participants will camp in the grounds of The Hayes and the focus will be on sustainability.

BARMOOR: YORKSHIRE

JULY 16-20 (Mon-Fri) £30

We offer young people with Autism aged 15-25 a fun week developing social skills, enjoying the Yorkshire moors, coast & peace of Barmoor. Volunteer helpers aged 18-30 are also required & training will be provided.

BEDFORD WOOD: BEDFORDSHIRE

JULY 21-28 (Sat-Sat) £150

This project is for Young Friends aged 18-30+. We will be working at the Quaker Wood in the Marston Vale Forest and staying at the Bedford Meeting House.

BAMFORD: PEAK DISTRICT

SEPTEMBER 8-15 (Sat-Sat) £160

In collaboration with 'Living Witness' the Quaker sustainability project, we return to the Quaker Community at Bamford for work on the land and refurbished buildings.

SWARTHMOOR: CUMBRIA

OCTOBER 8-12 (Mon-Fri) £120

Our Autumn visit to Swarthmoor includes seasonal gardening tasks such as tree work. Evenings around the bonfire and indoor log fire will help warm our spirits! Quaker roots at Swarthmoor go back to the 17th Century.

RAMALLAH: PALESTINE & ISRAEL

OCTOBER 20-31 (Sat-Wed) £390

We return to the region for our annual support of the olive picking harvest. The study and encounter element with the Palestinian/Israeli situation is based in and around the Friends International Centre in Ramallah near Jerusalem, and in Tel Aviv.

A preparation day will be held on 22nd Sept.
