Food is vegetarian and we cook together. Accommodation is in single or twin en suite rooms, and work activities - based in the garden and grounds, or in the historic house - vary to suit abilities and ages 18 to 80+. Your facilitators will be Linda Southwick and Simon Watkins.

Our events are open to Quakers and to those who wish to learn more about the Quaker way. There are half hour Meetings for Worship each morning, and days close with an Epilogue.
